This is a story about Mr. Garkpee Sayway, a man with a dependent of eight (8) with the responsibility of providing for them and ensuring that they are secured as a family.

It has been quite a difficult task for him, a man without basic skills to earn a living for himself least to mention his dependents.

God has been faithful through our work in the Kpayee Town community. Under the Sustainable Empowerment Program, we

have been teaching on how to utilize available resources in our environment. The greatest task is the identification of these potential resources.

Like Mr. Sayway, who is a member of our Fellowship have come to realize that the soil around him is one of the potential means that could transform his life.

We bought him some seeds and now he earns ten United States dollars (\$10) weekly from sales of his crops.



One of the ladies, Sister Garmen who was helped with a Table Business Loan, has extended her business into running a shop from profit of initial sales. She now pays her children school fees and provides for them.
