TIPS FOR PARENTS

The purpose of this program is to create a healthy relationship between parents and their children. As it is said, "the family is the bare rock of a society". Societies benefit from the hard work families go through in raising up a child to becoming useful citizen.

In this ever going world of technology and the many other factors influencing the behavior of our children, taking the family value system which was meant to build a healthy and civilized society, we have been challenged as a church to step in and save the next generation.

Parents are brought together to discuss some of the behaviors observed in their children and come up with remedies using biblical principles to these problems.

This meeting sets a platform to hear

from experienced and professionals who through the wisdom of God, provide TIPS for parents to rescue their perishing children from the grips of the devil.

Prayers are offered for kids that are



strongly under demonic attack and influence. Parents are also taught the importance of their roles in the lives of these children.

Our prayer is that opportunities will be created for some of these parents who have no means of catering to their children.

YOUTH WITH PURPOSE

In our times and days, the preparation for the transitional period for a take over by the next generation can not be over emphasized. We do not want to neglect this opportunity of reaching our youthful generation.

ART gathers youth in the Kpayou Town Community and share the gospel with them.

SAVING A CHILD IS RESCUING A WHOLE NATION

At present, we run a youth soccer team in bid to bring the young people together to teach them in becoming useful people in the community.

We also seek for opportunities to get some of these kids in school whose parents can not afford to provide

education for them.

ART provided \$30. US to a parent in helping with his kids who were kicked out of school. He could not meet up with his financial obligation due to the lack of job.

Kids are so dear to us and so we are committed to every child true purpose of existence being realized with the help of God.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

This program is focused on providing essential needs that benefit the community. A cooperative approach that lightens the spirit of unity and concern for one another.

Many of the community dwellers in the Kpayou Town have to go distances to get safe drinking water. The 14year civil war destroyed infrastructures including the hydro that provided us with safe drinking water.

Though the effort of the government has made it possible for some of the areas in Monrovia to receive water, majority of the people that dwell outside of Monrovia are yet to be reached.

ART in partnership with the Table in Oregon is now involved with providing a hand pump that will benefit many.

SUSTAINABLE EMPOWERMENT

We realized that most parents have lost control of their parental role because of their inability to sustain and provide for their dependants. Since the family plays a major role in the building of a nation, it is vital to us that issues and elements affecting the stability and the managerial role of parents in the home be handled to avoid the production of deviants that will not benefit the nation.

In light of this, we have drawn a focus point to facilitating and building the capacity of people for sustainable living.

There are a number of our people who have not developed themselves either because of the long civil war or of lack of proper education which have rendered them being liabilities. Some can not afford a meal a day and a lot of

other **political factors** that deride their chances of sustainable living.

Liberia is rich in natural resources but,

that is not visible in the lives of the people. There are a few who benefit from the wealth of the nation while rendering others to struggle for life.

As a church, we have a role to play in the transformation of our nation. Being cognizant of the fact that the nation is made up of the community, we have considered the aspect of building the capacity of individuals that will experience a lasting empowerment for sustainable living.

The scripture says "God has given us all things pertaining to life "and it is incumbent upon us to locate those things in our environment for survival.
